



This bulletin reports the results of the census of students of language background other than English in New South Wales government schools undertaken by the NSW Department of Education and Training on Friday, 11th March 2011. A student of language background other than English (LBOTE) is defined as one in whose home a language other than English is spoken.

INTRODUCTION

In March 2011, 224,794 students enrolled at Government schools were identified as being of language background other than English (LBOTE). This represented 29.6 percent of all Government school enrolments compared to 29.4 percent in 2010.

Tables 1 & 2 ENROLMENTS OF STUDENTS OF LANGUAGE BACKGROUND OTHER THAN ENGLISH BY REGION AND LEVEL/YEAR OF SCHOOLING, MARCH 2011

LBOTE student enrolments represented 29.2 percent of all primary enrolments and 30.3 percent of all secondary enrolments in Government schools. From 1998 to 2003 enrolments were reported by District. In 2004 the reporting unit was changed to School Education Area (SEA), and to Region in 2005. The percentage of LBOTE enrolments is highest in Year 12 at 34.7%

Chinese, with 39,593 students in 2011, has been the most common language background other than English in Government schools since 1997. Students from the Chinese language group background are 17.6 percent of all LBOTE students in 2011, compared to 18 percent in 2010. Arabic, with 29,402 students in 2011, was the most common language background from 1988 to 1996. The proportion of LBOTE students of Arabic background was 13.1 percent in 2011, compared to 12.9 percent in 2010.

South Western Sydney has the highest LBOTE student enrolments (85,502). New England has the lowest LBOTE student enrolments (637). Khmer and Lao were the languages with the highest concentration in one region, South Western Sydney.

Government preschools enrolled 1,843 students of language background other than English in 2011, representing 42 percent of all Government preschool enrolments. This year preschool enrolments are reported by largest language groups. LBOTE enrolments less than 10 (approximately 0.5%) are included in "Others" on this table.

The four metropolitan regions (Northern Sydney, South Western Sydney, Sydney and Western Sydney) enrol nearly 55 percent of all students. However they enrol 90.5 percent of students with a language background other than English.

In prior years, LBOTE information was collected in the midyear census, with comparative enrolment information collected at the same time.

Figure 1. Percentage of Students with Language Background Other Than English by Region, 2011





Figure 2. Students of Language Background Other Than English 1998 to 2011
