



LANGUAGE BACKGROUND OTHER THAN ENGLISH, 2007

This bulletin reports the results of the census of students of language background other than English in New South Wales government schools undertaken by the NSW Department of Education and Training on Tuesday, 1st May 2007. A student of language background other than English is defined as one in whose home a language other than English is spoken.

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INTRODUCTION

In May 2007, 207,031 students enrolled at government schools were identified as being of Language Background Other Than English (LBOTE). This represented 27.6 percent of all government school enrolments compared to 27.4 percent in 2006.

LBOTE student enrolments represented 27.9 percent of all primary enrolments and 27.2 percent of all secondary enrolments in government schools. From 1998 to 2003 enrolments were reported by District. In 2004 the reporting unit was changed to School Education Area (SEA), and to Region in 2005. In 2007 the reporting date was moved from March to May.

Chinese, with 37,716 students in 2007, has been the most common language background other than English in government schools since 1997. This year information on Cantonese and Mandarin language backgrounds has again been reported in addition to those students whose Chinese language background is not further resolved. Students from the Chinese language group background represented 18.2 percent of all LBOTE students in 2007, compared to 17.7 percentage in 2006. Arabic, with 26,626 students in 2007, was the most common language background from 1988 to 1996. The proportion of LBOTE students of Arabic background increased from 12.6 percent in 2006 to 12.9 percent in 2007.

Languages reported by 1,000 students or fewer were included in "Other". For the first time, Afrikaans, Assyrian, Bengali, Maori and Thai have been reported separately.

South Western Sydney has the highest LBOTE student enrolments (80,825).

New England has the lowest LBOTE student enrolments (425).

Khmer and Lao were the languages with the highest concentration in one Region.

Government preschools enrolled the equivalent of 936.2 full-time students of Language Background Other Than English in 2007, representing 36.4 percent of all government preschool enrolments, compared with 35.4 percent in 2006.




